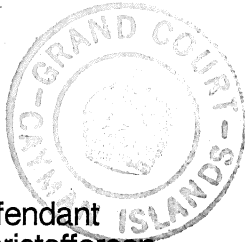

LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after service of this Summons on her, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service form to the Courts Office, P.O Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman.


By this summons, which is issued on the application of AAGE JENSEN of # 27 Viers Close, Spotts, Grand Cayman, the applicant seeks against the Defendant, the following Orders:-

- (a) An accounting from the Defendant of all the rents she collected in respect of her rental of the property at 21 Viers Close, since on or about September 2006.
- (b) A payment from the Defendant equivalent to 1/3 of all these rents collected from her in respect of the property.
- (c) A declaration that he is entitled to a 1/3 share in the market value of the property at # 27 Viers Close, Spotts, and registered at Spotts, Block 24 B, Parcel 16
- (d) A declaration that he is entitled to a 1/2 share in the market value of property registered at Midland East, Block 59 A, Parcel 253
- (e) A declaration that the Defendant is entitled to a 1/2 share in Honda Ridgeline Motor Truck registered at 118 112
- (f) A declaration that the Defendant is entitled to a 1/2 share in the value of all the furniture and furnishings in the home at 27 Viers Close, Spotts
- (e) A declaration that the Defendant is not entitled to any interest in phoenix flybridge cruiser boat, named " My Toy"
- (g) An order that the Defendant or whether by her servants and/ or agents be restrained from entering or remaining on the property at 27 Viers Close, Spotts, until a separation of the parties' joint assets
- (h) Costs

(i) Any other or further relief as this Honourable Court deems just.

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgement may be given or order made against or in relation to them, as the court may think just and expedient.

Notes for guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessarily (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes " box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is used in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorized to act on behalf for the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
8. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
9. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office

NOTES ON ADDRESS FOR SERVICE

Attorney: Where the Respondent is represented by an Attorney, state the Attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Respondent may not act by a foreign Attorney.

Respondent in person: Where the Respondent is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and the physical address of his residence, or if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent.
